
How I Created My Family Book

Next Step


- Gather (scan) the photos

Organize

- Put everything in one folder
- Label everything for easy identification
- Example:
 - Family Book
 - Smith Family
 - George Smith 1890.tiff
 - George Smith.docx



Refine the Stories

- Review each story and any related photos
- Refine the story (1st edit)
- Start making notes on what order the families/individuals should be placed in the book
- Example: Start with parents and work back OR
 Start with earliest ancestor and work forward

Compile the Text

- Place the text of each story in one document
- Examine how the stories fit together
- Refine placement or edit for a better fit
- Create an outline for a table of contents
- Write an opening paragraph, dedication, or other beginning text

Assemble the Book

- Begin the book in what ever tool you will be using
- Decide page layout
- Refine text if necessary to fit
- Beg someone to proof read the entire book
- Beg someone else to proof read a second time (Not kidding!)

Cover and Contents

- Finalize the table of contents
- Decide on a cover style/image
- Decide on your title

Publish

- That's it, you're done.
- Well... you'll be on pins and needles waiting for the finished product to arrive in the mail.
